ITINERARY BAÑOS FULL-DAY

- **Pick-up at 07h00**

- **Arrival in Baños**

This city is located between two National Parks, Sangay and Llanganates. Here, we will have the first stop in the city center.

- **Waterfall Route**

The Waterfall route starts from the center of Baños, crossing the city, then continues to the Agoyán waterfall. After that, we visit Manto de la Novia waterfall, where we can cross the river in a cable car, go through tunnels, and finally, after a hike we reach the impressive Pailón del Diablo waterfall. For an extra payment, you have the opportunity to do adventure activities such as jumping from the bridges, canopy, cycling, hiking, and canyoning.

- **Visit The Treehouse and Swing of the End of the World**

At the Treehouse viewpoint in Baños, you can enjoy breathtaking panoramic views of the surrounding lush greenery, mountains, and the Tungurahua volcano. It offers a unique perspective of nature.





The Swing at the End of the World, located here, is a thrilling experience. Swinging off the edge of a cliff, you'll feel like you're suspended in the open air with jaw-dropping scenery in the background. It's a must-visit spot for adventure seekers and photography enthusiasts.
